



A pooled procurement agency that provides excellent procurement and supply chain management of medical products to the OECS Member States public sector





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


OECS Pharmaceutical Procurement Service

- Established in 1986
- Medicine cartel
- OECS Economic Union
- Country-based committees
- Payments through Central Bank
- Self-financing with 9% surcharge
- Shared culture, language, ethnicity, currency
- Restricted International bid for 840 items with 20 suppliers

Benefits of pooled procurement

Economic

- Economies of scale, ↓ prices,20%
- Monopsony, ↑ bargaining power
- Fixed, common price for tender period



Procurement

Annual purchases for FY17/18 : EC\$28.86M 20% savings : EC\$ 5.80 M




Benefits of Pooled Procurement

Non- economic, value-added

- Enhanced quality assurance
- Coordinated training, research, M&E
- Regional cooperation and integration
- Harmonized formulary manual, STGs
- Sharing of information and pharmaceutical intelligence

Electronic pooled procurement system, E-PPSS

Three main modules

Pre-Procurement

Procurement

- Registers suppliers
- Pre-qualifies suppliers
- Aggregates forecasts
- Creates tenders
- Invite bids
- Evaluates tenders
- Awards contracts
- Requisition orders
- Places purchase orders
- Accepts invoices
- Process Goods Received Notes

Suriname

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Lessons Learnt from E-ppss

- Increased suppliers' confidence
- Improved procurement system design
- Increased productivity reusable templates
- Eliminates errors: automatic PO's processing
- Reduce cost: staff time, paper-work, automated reports
- Compliance with policy: controls, levels of authorization
- Shortened procurement cycle: e-enabled bid aggregation

Principles of Drug Selection

- Established criteria
- Scrutinize new medicines
- Determined only by the DTC
- FDCs with superior advantages
- Drugs of choice for prevalent diseases

Selection

Advantages of Formulary


- Drug therapy is improved
- Procurement is enhanced
- Distribution cost is reduced
- Purchasing power is strengthened
- Inventory holding cost is decreased

What is Pharmacovigilance?

WHO definition:

The science and activities relating to the detection, assessment, understanding and prevention of adverse effects or any other drug-related problem.

Limitations of Pre-marketing Phase

- Short duration
- Limited pts; age
- Conditions; controlled
- Limited size; <5000 pts before licensing
- Need 30k pts to detect rare ADR 1/10,000
- Absence of co-morbidity and special groups

Why Pharmacovigilance?


- Genetics, diet, culture
- How product is prescribed
- Concurrent use of herbal medicines
- ADR monitoring is a key regulatory tool for safe and effective medicines

Indicators

- Weighted average percentage of inventory variation
- Average percentage of available medicines
- Average of time that indicator medicines were out of stock
- Service level for prescribed medicines

Indicators cont'd

- Warehouse assessment
- Percentage of requisitions delivered on time
- Percentage of consignments cleared on schedule
- Value of expired products








Cost of 1st Line ARV PPPY-TDF/FTC/EFV

N.B. Cost of ATV/r = LPV/r per day






Cost of 2nd line ARVs, PPPY
