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



Lessons

- If you do not create a structure, one will be created for you
- Not every healthcare professional is alike
- Fear can drive misinterpretation
- Pressure sometimes requires stronger regulation or at least a stern discussion
- Make sure everyone gets a voice, even if you have to build a platform for them to stand on
- Talk clearly but also listen intentionally
- Regulate with flexibility. No regulatory framework is perfect
- It isn't personal, unless you make it so
- You can change things by actually stating where things are obviously wrong. Regulation is not a passive exercise.







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
