In keeping with recommendations from last year's Conference, the 16th Conference focuses on *'Information Systems, AI and Data Analytics in Health: Managing Costs, Optimising Benefits for the Caribbean'*. Key areas of emphasis will be:-

- global, regional and national perspectives on cost effective design and implementation of health information systems, AI and Chat Gpt;
- experiences of end users and provider agencies in managing costs and benefits of IT systems, including the role of public-private partnerships;
- ongoing country progress in advancing Universal Health Coverage; and
- a special panel on new directions in health financing featuring presentations by young researchers.


